ALL educational institutions, offices and business complexes in the district came alive with patriotic fervour on the occasion of the nation's 70th Republic Day celebrations on Saturday.

Every street looked clean and fresh in the temple town and special arrangements were made to celebrate the Republic Day.

The district administration organised loan grounding programme and Collector PS Pradyumna distributed a total of ₹275.26 crore worth of loans and assets.

The DRDA project director had given cheques worth ₹63.43 crore to 2,139 members and MEPMA issued cheques worth ₹150 crore to 7,008 persons.

BC Corporation issued ₹6.8 crore to 3,857 people under the Aadarana Scheme-2 while SC Corporation provided ₹1.4-crore loans to 65 members.

As many as 63 people belonging to Minorities were distributed cash worth ₹ 1.12 crore, and tractors, electric motors and others under various schemes.

Through DWCR, 4.5 lakh rural women were extended an assistance of ₹ 1,571 crore.

As part of the celebrations, students of the Government Degree College, Chittoor, performed 'Desh Me Rangala' a dance ballet which attracted the audience.

Several other groups presented patriotic songs, ballets and monologues.

Students of Sudha English Medium School, Tirupati, recited slokas (poetry) and patriotic songs.

District Yoga Association, yoga ashram students and others performed yoga.

All departments exhibited their achievements. The tableau of RWS Department won the first place.

TTD EO Singhal unveils developmental activities

MAHA Samprokshanam will be performed at the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) constructed Lord Venkateswara temple on Swamy Vivekananda Trust office premises in Kanyakumari, on Sunday.

Addressing the staff and gathering at the flag-hoisting ceremony on the occasion of nation's 70th Republic Day, Singhal disclosed major developmental activities and construction of temples across the nation.

The EO said that Kurukshetra, which is known as the battleground of Pandavas and Kauravas in Mahabharat, recently a temple worth ₹34.6 crore was opened in Kurukshetra.

"Around the TTD temple in Kurukshetra, there is Brahm Sarovar; Kurukshetra battleground, Sri Krishna temple and several auspicious and important places," Singhal explained.

Singhal said that an ancient temple of Sri Rama at Vontimitta is being developed at a cost of ₹100 crore on the lines of Lord Venkateswara temple at Tirumala.

He said that there are plans to construct 2,000 rooms in Tirupati and as part of this project, ₹ 112 crore was sanctioned.

₹150-CRORE TEMPLE AT AMARAVATI

The EO said that on January 31, a puja would be performed and construction of a ₹150-crore temple would be started at the State's new capital Amaravati.

"Divya Kshetram works of ₹7.9 crore are underway in Visakhapatnam along with Vithampet, Parvathipuram in Vizianagaram district and Rampachodavaram in East Godavari district at a total cost of ₹13.5 crore," he said.

He said ₹74.7 crore worth of rooms at Padmavati Choultry on Tiruchanur Highway will be opened to public in March and added that queue lines would be constructed at Narayanagiri Gardens at a cost of ₹23 crore apart from toilets being built at a cost of ₹6.41 crore.

The EO said that ₹21.12 crore worth of elevation works would be taken up at all Kalyana Mandapams in Tirupati along with renovation of choultries in Tirumala at a cost of ₹119 crore.

He said that ₹3.5 crore had been sanctioned for exclusive green covering at Tirumala.
