Making 'false' complaint against J&K govt official could invite penal action

New circular says that in cases where an inquiry finds a complaint false, administration will 'pursue prosecution'

MAKING A complaint against a government official without any material substance could attract penal action in Jammu and Kashmir. According to a new circular, the administration will "pursue prosecution" in cases where an inquiry finds a com-

The General Administrative Department's circular, issued to all administrative departments, heads of departments, cadre controlling authorities and the public servants said such action should be under Section 182 of the Indian Penal Code and section 195(1)(a) of the Code of Criminal Procedure,1973, "based on a complaint filed with the court by the concerned public servant or another superior public servant".

While section 182 of the IPC deals with "false information, with intent to cause a public servant to use his lawful power to the injury of another person", Section 195 (1) (a) of the CrPC deals with prosecution for contempt of lawful authority of

The IPC section carries jail term for up to six months.

However, in the case of public servants making false complaints, the circular, which Commissioner-Secretary of the Administration Department Sanieev Verma has issued, asks for "considering departmental action" against them "as an alternative to prosecu-

"A robust and effective mechanism for redressal of complaints against public servants with detailed instructions, have been issued from time to time, with a view to balance the objectives of good governance for establishing a corruptionfree, transparent and responsive administrative system, alongwith ensuring adequate safeguards for public servants to protect them from unnecessary harassment false/frivolous/anonymous/pse

udonymous complaints," it The copies of the circular

have been marked to all financial commissioners (additional chief secretaries), the director general of I&K Police, all principal secretaries to the government, special director general of police (J&K Crime Branch), and principal secretary to the Lieutenant Governor, among

The circular said such action is necessary "in order to ensure that honest public servants are not unfairly harassed, and the government business is not af-

For such affected officers, it asks administrative departments, heads of departments and public servants to shall provide "institutional support" by "assisting the affected employee to approach Crime Branch, J&K, for initiation of criminal proceedings, facilitate them in filing civil lawsuits against responsible individuals seeking compensation for financial losses, emotional distress, or harm to reputation, with the provision for the public servant to engage a lawyer as per requirement on contingency fee arrangements, subject to available resources, for which each

case shall be decided on merits". It also asked for "facilitating assistance of Law Officers from the Department of Law, Justice & Parliamentary Affairs for appropriate legal remedies in respect of acts done in official capacity, arranging formal inquiries by the relevant registering authority, where such complaints have been filed by any such registered organizations, issuance of formal press notes regarding complaints and inquiries to promote transparency, preferably on a

Chandrayaan-4 to be sent in parts, assembled in space: ISRO chief

CHANDRAYAAN-4, WHICH is supposed to bring back samples from the Moon, would not be launched at one go and instead, different parts of the spacecraft would be sent into orbit through two launches, and the spacecraft would be assembled in space before proceeding to the Moon, ISRO Chairman S Somanath said Wednesday

The International Space Station and all previous similar facilities were built by assembling different parts in space. However, this would be probably the first time in the world

launched in parts and then assembled in space.

"...We have worked out the configuration of Chandrayaan-4... how to bring back samples from Moon to Earth. We propose to do it with multiple launches because our current rocket capability is not (strong) enough to do it at one go," Somanath said on the sidelines of an event in Delhi.

"So, we have to have docking capability (joining of different parts of a spacecraft) in space both in Earth space as well as in Moon space. We are developing that capability. We have a mission called Spadex scheduled later this year to demonstrate this capability." Somanath said.

Docking of spacecraft mod-

Moon is a fairly routine manoeuvre. A part of spacecraft detaches from the main spacecraft and makes a landing while the other part remains in the Moon orbit. When the landing part leaves the Moon's surface, it docks and links up with the orbiting part, becoming one unit again.

However, it would be the first instance of docking of modules in Earth orbit for the onward journey to the Moon, "We are not making any claims to be the first one to attempt this, but yes, I am not aware of anyone else having

Somanath said that a detailed study internal review and cost for the Chandrayaan-4 mission have been worked out which will be sent to the government for approval. This is one of the four project proposals that the space agency plans seek approval for in line with its Vision 2047, which has envisioned India building its own space station by 2035 and sending hu-

mans to the Moon by 2040. India's space station, named Bharatiya Antariksh Station (BAS), would also be set up by

frastructure in multiple launches.

"The first segment of the BAS can be launched using (the current) LVM3 rocket as it is the only rocket available today and we have decided that by 2028 we should have the first launch of the BAS. For this, we are prepar ing another proposal for government approval," Somanath said.

He said details of other mod ules of the BAS will be worked out in due course. "We have a five module configuration, mul tiple committees are working on how to develop this," he said.

WITH ONLY a few days left for the three new criminal laws -Sanhita. Bharatiya Nyaya Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, and Bharatiya Sakshya Act — to come into force on July 1, Union Home Secretary Ajay Bhalla has directed all the States/ UTs to organise an event informing about the key features of the law across all the police stations on the same date, The Indian Express has learnt. So far, over 5.65 lakh police, prison, forensics, judicial and prosecution officials have been trained to implement the new laws.

Earlier, Bhalla had held back to back meetings Tuesday and Wednesday with all the Chief Secretaries of UTs and the DGPs of states to review the progress for implementation of the laws. "During the meeting, he is learnt to have asked all the DGs to organise an event in every police station inviting at least 100 people and informing them about the key fea-
