## Naidu hails BJP's victory in Haryana assembly poll

**Vijayawada:** Following the hat-trick victory in Haryana and a decent show in the Jammu and Kashmir assembly elections, the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) renewed its push for the 'One Nation, One Election' idea. This time, it was TDP president and Andhra Pradesh chief minister N Chandrababu Naidu, a key NDA alliance partner, who pitched the idea of having simultaneous elections for the Centre, state assemblies, and for local bodies, too. Naidu congratulated PM Narendra Modi and the BJP leadership for steering the party to a third-time victory in Haryana and emerging as a strong force in Jammu and Kashmir. He said BJP's victory reflected people's trust in Modi and good governance by the BJP government in the last 10 years. "Andhra Pradesh stands as a case study of what happens if a person with a destructive ideology comes to power," said Naidu. **TNN**

## 'Poor ashamed to send kids to govt schools'

### Dispel The Bad Image Of Govt Schools: T CM

**Hyderabad:** Chief minister A Revanth Reddy on Wednesday said that even the poorest of the poor in villages save money to send their children to private schools, as they feel it is a disgrace to send them to govt schools. He appealed to the teachers that this stigma should be eradicated and that people should feel proud of education in govt schools.

Former president and scientist APJ Abdul Kalam and many great personalities were products of govt schools, he said, addressing 11,062 newly-recruited govt school teachers and their parents at a programme to give them appointment letters at LB Stadium here. "There are 30,000 govt schools in the state with 24 lakh students. Then there are 10 lakh private schools with 34 lakh students enrolled with them. Are the private school teachers more qualified or more efficient than their govt school coun-

terparts?" he wondered.

The bad image of govt schools should be dispelled. The Congress govt is giving top priority to education, spending over ₹21,000 crore on the education sector, recruiting teachers and attendants, and has given the maintenance of govt schools to women self-help groups.

"Why should parents feel ashamed to send their children to govt schools? Teachers have a big responsibility in shaping future generations. Contribute to reconstruction and development of Telangana," the CM said and administered a pledge to the newly-recruited teachers towards achieving this endeavour. He said the previous govt

even delayed the district selection committee notification by three years after the formation of Telangana state, and candidates for the posts were made to wait two years for appointments, which were given in 2019.

"As per the promise made by us, we have initiated job placements. Within just 90 days of coming to power, the Congress govt has given appointment letters to 30,000 candidates, and another 30,000 will also soon get jobs. Today, over 11,000 teachers are receiving appointment letters," CM Revanth said.

The Congress govt has completed long-pending transfers of 34,000 teachers and promotions of 21,000.

## 'Explore new ways to boost revenue'

**Hyderabad:** Deputy chief minister Bhatti Vikramarka on Wednesday directed officials to explore methods for enhancing state revenue without implementing price rises.

In a review meeting convened with senior officials from various departments to discuss strategies for revenue enhancement, he urged officials to come prepared with specific proposals aimed at boosting revenue.

Additionally, he recommended that updates be provided on the progress of previously established initiatives.

A special meeting was mandated with the commercial

taxes commissioner, joint Commissioner, and heads of departments to address revenue leakages and improve financial intake.

Bhatti emphasized the need to fortify the enforcement department to prevent the sale of liquor at prices exceeding the Maximum Retail Price (MRP) in liquor outlets. Various departments were encouraged to collaborate effectively to augment state revenue and to conduct joint meetings for this objective.

To tackle illegal sand transportation and tax evasions, a report was sought from officials present in the meeting on commercial taxes, roads, and buildings. Relevant personnel were urged to expedite decisions regarding the sale of completed and pending houses under the Rajiv Swagruha and housing department.

## Boy crossing road hit by auto, killed

**Hyderabad:** A 7-year-old boy was killed in an accident when an auto trolley hit him while he was crossing the road in Bheemgal town of Nizamabad district on Wednesday night.

According to police, the incident took place when the boy, identified as T Niswant of Nandigalli, was returning home from a shop. While crossing the road near his house, the auto trolley hit the boy at high speed. The boy was thrown into the air and landed on main road a few metres away. He was rushed to a private hospital and pronounced dead. On the complaint of boy's parents, cops registered a case against the auto trolley driver, Afroz, and arrested him. The vehicle was also impounded.
