SC to Delhi HC: **Consider Sharjeel** Imam plea to expedite his bail hearing

THE SUPREME Court Priday asked the Delhi High Court to consider activist Sharjeel Imam's plea to expedite his bail hearing in the larger conspiracy case related to the 2020 northesa Delhi roiss.

A bench of Justices Bela M Trived and Sarish Chandra Sharma said that Imam's shall be at liberty to request the High Court to hear the ball application as expeditiously as possible on the next date and it is expected that the High Court shall consider the said request.

He and many others were booked under rele-vant provisions of the stringent UAPA and IPC for allegedly being the "masterminds" of the riots in northeast Delhi in February 2020. The riots had erupted amid protests against the Citizenship Amendment Act in the city and left more than 50 people

On May 29 this year, the High Court granted Imam statutory bail in the sedition case filed against him over alleged inflammatory's speeches at Aligaria Muslim University and in the Jamia area during the anti-CAA protests. The High Court is due to hear his plea next on November 25.
