

SC to Delhi HC: Consider Sharjeel Imam plea to expedite his bail hearing

THE SUPREME COURT Friday asked the Delhi High Court to consider activist Sharjeel Imam's plea to expedite his bail hearing in the larger conspiracy case related to the 2020 northeast Delhi riots.

A bench of Justices Bela M Trivedi and Satish Chandra Sharma said that Imam 'shall be at liberty to request the High Court to hear the bail application as expeditiously as possible on the next date and it is expected that the High Court shall consider the said request'.

Imam had eight FIRs against him but Dave said the application pertains to only the larger conspiracy behind the riots case. Imam had approached the High Court after the trial court denied him bail. He and many others were booked under relevant provisions of the stringent UAPA and IPC for allegedly being the "masterminds of the riots in northeast Delhi in February 2020. The riots had erupted amid protests against the citizenship Amendment Act in the city and left more than 50 people dead.

On May 29 this year, the High Court granted Imam statutory bail in the section 149 case filed against him over alleged inflammatory speeches at Aligarh Muslim University and in the Jamia area during the anti-CAA protests. The High Court is due to hear his plea next on November 25.

ODISHA Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi on Friday declared the government's "zero-casualty" mission a success after cyclone Dana made landfall in the state between Dhamra and Habalikhati nature camp in Bhitarkanika early on Friday with wind speed of 100-120 kmph.

The landfall process started at midnight and continued into the morning. There were reports of damage to thatched houses and disruption of road transportation in some parts of Odisha's northern districts. Power lines were also damaged in some areas.

WEST BENGAL CM Mamata Banerjee Friday confirmed that one person died in the state even as the administration evacuated around 2.16 lakh people from the low-lying areas and the authorities continue to be on alert after Cyclone Dana's landfall.

While the "severe" Cyclone Dana spared West Bengal from large-scale destruction unlike previous storms such as Amphan and Bulbul, it brought embankments and breached torrential rains, causing considerable property damage in the southern areas, keeping the administration on high alert even after the storm passed on Friday morning. The storm brought rain and strong winds to many parts of West Bengal, particularly Purba Medinipur and South 24 Parganas.

ected to be normalised soon. Of the over 6 lakh people who were evacuated from vulnerable and low-lying areas and accommodated at cyclone shelters, many have started returning to their homes, officials said. IMD sources said the storm has moved north-northwestwards at a speed of 10 kmph and now centred over north-coastal Odisha, about 30 km northeast of Bhadrak and 50 km north-northwest of Dhamra. It will gradually weaken into a deep depression, resulting in heavy to very heavy rainfall in the state. Red alerts for rain have been issued in Jajpur, Khordha, Puri, Dhenkanal, Bhubani, Cuttack, Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, and Angul districts.

Friday after holding a review meet, Banerjee said one person had died of electrocution in South 24 Parganas's Pathapatna. "He was doing some work with networking cables at his residence when he died. The post-mortem will give a clearer picture. We will help the family freed," the CM said. The CM also ordered a survey to assess crop losses and give district authorities 48 hours to submit their reports.
