

## Fire erupts at another pharma unit in AP, 4 hurt

FOUR workers were injured in yet another industrial accident, the second one in three days, at a unit of Synerge Active Ingredients Pvt Ltd located in the Jawaharlal Nehru Pharma City (JN Pharma City) at Parawada in Anakapalle district. According to officials, the fire broke out around 12.30 am on the first floor in the B Block of pharma unit on Friday.

The incident comes close on the heels of the explosion at Escientia Advanced Sciences Private Ltd in Atchutapuram SEZ on Wednesday, which claimed 17 lives and left 36 people injured.

Officials said the fire erupted during the process of mixing chemicals. The static electricity caused the fire. The injured workers have been identified as K Suryanarayana (36) from Vizianagaram, and Oybonkorha (22), Lalsingh Purthy (24) and Roya Angaria (22) from Jharkhand. All the four are undergoing treatment at Indus Hospital.

CM N Chandrababu Naidu enquired about the incident and directed officials to provide better treatment to the injured.

## NHRC seeks report in two weeks on pharma unit fire

TAKING suo motu cognisance of the fire accident at a unit of Escientia Advanced Sciences Private Limited in the Atchutapuram SEZ in Anakapalle district which claimed 17 lives and left several workers injured, the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) has issued notices to the state government and the police to investigate whether the safety norms and legal provisions were strictly followed by the management. The Commission has sought a detailed report within two weeks.

NHRC observed that the contents of the media reports indicate violations of the victims' Right to Life due to the concerned authorities' negligence.

### 'Cause will be ascertained after clearing debris'

Vijayawada: Officials from the Factories Department stated that the precise cause of the major accident at Escientia Advanced Sciences Private Limited in Atchutapuram Special Economic Zone (SEZ), Rambilli mandal, Anakapalle district, will only be determined after the debris is cleared and a thorough ground inspection is conducted. Speaking to TNE, Director (Factories) D Chandra Sekhara Varma mentioned that they are awaiting further instructions from the government, as Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu has announced the formation of a committee to investigate the incident.

Accordingly, notices have been issued to the chief secretary and the director general of police, directing them to launch a thorough investigation to check whether all safety norms and legal provisions were being strictly followed by the owner of the industrial unit and supervised by the authorities concerned.

"The report must include the status of the FIR, updated information on the health and medical treatment of the injured, disbursement of the compensation, and any other relief provided to the injured as well as the families of the deceased workers," the Commission said.

Further, NHRC said it would also like to know about the action taken against the delinquent officers responsible for the tragedy.



## SIT files 144-page chargesheet against Prajwal

The Crime Investigation Department (CID) of the Special Investigation Team (SIT) on Friday filed a 144-page chargesheet against Holenarasipura MLA HD Revanna and former Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna in connection with the sexual assault and harassment case registered at the Holenarasipura Town police station in Hassan.

The investigation officer of the case submitted the chargesheet to the 42nd Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (ACMM) court, which is the Special Court to try cases against sitting and former MPs/MLAs.

The SIT has included the statement of about 150 witnesses in the case, including victims' and witnesses statements that were recorded before the magistrate under

Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC).

The SIT, which had subjected the accused to medical tests and had gathered biological, physical, scientific, mobile phone, digital and other circumstantial evidence during the course of investigation has also furnished the reports of medical, forensic and cyber forensic tests along with the

chargesheet.

The first case was filed on April 28 at Holenarasipura Town police station where Prajwal and his father Revanna were accused of sexual harassment of a 47-year-old former maid.

The Special Investigation Team had earlier submitted chargesheet against Prajwal Revanna and others in connection with the kidnap case, involving one of the sexual abuse victims, to the court.



## Expedite land acquisition process for Old City Metro: HMRL MD

THE Land Acquisition process for the Old City Metro stretch between MGBS and Chandrayangutta is being expedited, according to HMRL Managing Director NVS Reddy. As many as 1,200 properties will be affected by road widening and station construction over this 7.5 km stretch. Notifications have been issued for 400 properties so far under the Land Acquisition Act 2013.

Property owners can seek clarifications and file objections at the Land Acquisition Officer's office at HAML during the stipulated period. The entire land acquisition process is likely to take about eight



months, as per the LA Act procedures.

The road will be widened to 100 feet as per GHMC Master Plan. At Metro station locations, the road will be widened to 120 feet. Currently, the road width ranges from 50 to 60 feet between Darulshifa junction and Shalibanda junction and 80 feet between Shalibanda junction

and Chandrayangutta. Thus, the affected portion of each property will generally be about 20 to 25 feet from Darulshifa to Shalibanda and about 10 feet from Shalibanda to Chandrayangutta. The affected area may increase at station locations and in sections with sharp curves.

Reddy also noted that in addition to conventional survey methods, a Lidar drone survey was conducted to create a 3D view of the affected properties and neighbouring properties. To protect the 103 religious and other sensitive structures along this stretch, innovative engineering solutions and careful adjustments of Metro pillars and station locations are being made.

## Highly unhygienic conditions found in two restaurants in Hyderabad

THE food safety officials conducted inspections at two restaurants in Aramgarh on Friday and found highly unhygienic conditions. At Dar Al Mandi, Aramgarh. The officials found drain water stagnation and synthetic food colours used in food articles, which were discarded immediately. The FBO also failed to provide the FSSAI licence copy during the inspection.

At Golden Pears, the multi-cuisine restaurant, raw mutton pieces spillage was found inside a refrigerator and houseflies were observed inside kitchen premises. Additionally, expired milk and ghee packets were found and discarded.

Officials also conducted inspections in as many as 28 government and private residential schools and colleges across the city, as per the instructions of the GHMC Commissioner, Amrapali Kata.

## GHMC to distribute 6 lakh clay Ganesh idols free of cost in Hyd

TO create awareness and promote the use of eco-friendly clay Ganesh idols for the upcoming Ganesh Chaturthi festival on September 7, the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) will procure 3.10 lakh clay Ganesh idols and sell them free of cost to the citizens. These idols will come in three sizes and will be distributed to citizens through GHMC circles and zonal offices during the first week of September.

The Telangana Pollution Control Board's (TGPCB) will distribute 1 lakh clay idols within Greater Hyderabad limits and 64,000 idols in 32 districts in Telangana. Additionally, the Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Au-

thority (HMDA) will distribute over 1 lakh eight-inch clay idols at various locations across the city.

For the past decade, the state government has been advocating for Green Ganeshas or Clay Ganeshas. Last year, the response was positive, with many devotees opting for eco-friendly clay idols over Plaster of Paris

(PoP). The three bodies - GHMC, TGPCB and HMDA - distributed around 6 lakh clay Ganesh idols in the city.

The civic body has invited tenders from registered societies, firms, manufacturers, and suppliers to provide these idols. The agencies must deliver the idols by August 31, 2024, using their own or hired transport.

## Attention diversion gang held, ₹8.8L seized

THE Begumpet police, apprehended an attention diversion gang and seized gold jewellery and ₹8.82 lakh in cash.

The accused were identified as Irfan (49), Shakir (30), Rubi and Mohammed Feroz (38).

The gang's modus operandi was to divert the attention of their target at busy bus and railway stations. Irfan, the gang organiser, coordinated the activities, while Mohammed Feroz acted as an auto driver. Shakir and his wife Rubi posed as passengers. While Feroz ferried passengers in his shared auto, Shakir and Rubi would steal valuables from the victims' bags. Feroz would stop the auto, saying that the vehicle broke down giving his gang members a chance to flea.

## Fraudster impersonating adviser to CM arrested

RACHAKONDA police on Friday arrested one Anugu Surender Reddy, along with his three associates, on charges of impersonating Vem Narender Reddy, the adviser to the chief minister, and fleeing about 100 people of ₹1.04 crore.

Surender Reddy, aided by Merina Rose, Banda Venkatesh and Bolugula Lingaiah, are accused of promising government benefits and job placements to their victims.

Briefing reporters, Rachakonda Police Commissioner Sudheer Babu said that Surender Reddy is a mid-day meals organiser at the ZPHS Kusaiguda. "Sometimes impersonating Vem Narender Reddy and sometimes claiming high-level governmental influ-

ence, he convinced his victims that he could secure transfers, 2BHK allotments, and positions within the Food Corporation of India. He managed to lure his victims into paying huge sums for these nonexistent benefits," the police commissioner said.

Merina Rose is accused of introducing victims to Surender Reddy, who were then asked to give ₹5 lakh each for getting 2BHK flats that were never allocated. Rose, along with Banda Venkatesh and Bolugula Lingaiah, is accused of participating in similar schemes, promising jobs and other benefits, and extracting around ₹18.5 lakh from victims.

The police commissioner asked the general public to never approach any person or middleman for getting 2BHKs allocated.

## Government employees JAC announces pension betrayal day

Hyderabad: A steering committee of the Telangana Employees Joint Action Committee (JAC) was formed on Friday at the Telangana NGO Central Building in Nampally to address the pending issues of the state government employees. The committee consists of 27 members and will be led by its chairman Marri Jagadishwar and secretary-general Eluri Srinivasa Rao. In its first decision, the JAC decided to observe "pension betrayal day" on September 1 and said that protests will be held at all district collectorates and at the Gun Park in Hyderabad on the same day.
