World protests against Middle East war

OCTOBER 7 ANNIVERSARY

Thousands of protesters took to the streets in major cities around the world on Saturday demanding an end to bloodshed in Gaza and the wider Middle East ahead of the first anniversary of the deadly Hamas attack on Israel. More protests were planned in several cities on Sunday, according to reports by Reuters and Associated Press. About 40,000 pro-Palestinian demonstrators marched through central London, while thousands gathered in Paris, Rome, Manila, Cape Town and New York City. Demonstrations were also held near the White House in Washington, protesting against US support for Israel in military campaigns in Gaza and Lebanon. Protesters at New York's Times Square chanted slogans like: "Gaza, Lebanon you will rise, the people are by your side." They held banners demanding an arms embargo against Israel. The war in Gaza was triggered when Pa-

Lebanese Hamas militants attacked southern Israel on October 7, 2023, killing 1,200 people and taking about 250 as hostages, according to Israeli tallies. Nearly 100 Israeli hostages remain in Gaza, with fewer than 70 believed to be alive. Israel's subsequent military assault on Gaza has killed nearly 42,000 Palestinians, according to Gaza's health ministry.

It has laid waste to the enclave, displacing nearly all of the 2.3 million population and causing a hunger crisis. Nearly 100 Israeli hostages remain in Gaza, with fewer than 70 believed to be alive. In Jakarta, the world's most populous Muslim-majority country, at least 1,000 pro-Palestinian protesters gathered on Sunday morning near the US embassy



demanding that Washington stop supplying weapons to Israel. In London on Saturday, counter-demonstrators waved Israeli flags as pro-Palestinian marchers walked by.

Sri Lanka parties look for allies for Nov polls

All major political parties in Sri Lanka are shortlisting candidates and attempting to forge new alliances as the country prepares for the November 14 parliamentary election. No major party has yet submitted its nominations to contest any of the 22 electoral districts despite the opening of the nominations



on Friday last. The nominations for the election will close on October 11. The ruling National People's Power (NPP) Party, which won the September 21 presidential election, said it is in the process of finalising its candidates list.

Former president Ranil Wickremesinghe's United National Party (UNP) had unsuccessfully tried to merge with its offshoot Samagi Jana Balawegaya party to face the election. The split votes between Premadasa and Wickremesinghe helped incumbent Anura Kumara Dissanayake to win the presidential poll. The UNP is in the process of finalising an pact with groups which had broken away from the Rajapaksa family-dominated SLPP party.

Russian charged with treason

A Russian man jailed in February for burning the Koran has been charged with treason by prosecutors who accuse him of passing video footage of military movements to Ukraine, according to Reuters. Russia's prosecutor general's office said that 20-year-old Nikita Zhuravel was accused of sending footage of a freight train carrying warplanes, and information about the movements of a car linked to a Russian military base to a representative of Ukrainian intelligence. It said Zhuravel had volunteered himself to send the Ukrainian intelligence officer the data.
