

# Centre's Rs 250 Cr incentive to Chhattisgarh for digital reforms

The Centre on Tuesday, appreciating the digital reforms and the IT-based financial management system, provided Chhattisgarh an incentive of Rs 250 crore as Capital Expenditure (CapEx).  
A government official said the state has adopted the 'Just In Time' (JIT) model and SNA Spans systems as digital reforms in financial works. This has made the distribution, tracking and payments easier.  
The e-Kuber network and the Financial Management and Information System (FMIS) has resulted in appropriate use of funds on time and reporting has been



ensured on real time, he said. Apart from reforms in financial field, the government has also formed the Department of Good

Governance and Convergence for the successful implementation of the public welfare policies. e-review, e-public service

guarantees and digital secretary will now be the responsibility of the Department of Good Governance and

Convergence. As part of its initiative to enhance e-governance and transparency, the Chhattisgarh government has introduced a range of online platforms such as e-office system, the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) online portal and the Swagat portal.  
These platforms aim to improve efficiency, reduce corruption and integrate IT across various government sectors.  
The e-office system has digitized office documents, streamline file processing, and secure records against tampering or loss. The CMO portal is designed to keep citizens informed and engaged in the decision-making process.

# Two minors among six held for double murder

Chhattisgarh Police on Tuesday arrested six persons including two minor boys for killing two men after a fight in a bar over alcohol consumption in Raipur city.  
Kham Singh Sahu (47), his sons Durgesh (23) and Evarn Kumar (18), Dalendra Sahu (18) as well as a 16- and 17-year-old boys have been taken into custody, Raipur Senior Superintendent of Police Lal Umred Singh said.  
They killed Krishna Yadav (27) and Sachin Badole (29) on the night of December 30.  
The incident took place around 1 am at Kala Pula Chowk grounds in Changorabhata area when the accused were seated near a bonfire. Yadav and Badole



were consuming alcohol there. The six objected to this, sparking a verbal spat in a fit of rage, the former killed Yadav and Badole by crushing their heads with stone. The police rushed the

two to a hospital where doctors declared them dead. After a manhunt, the criminals were caught. A court sent four of them to prison and the two younger boys were sent to a juvenile home.

# Two minors killed, 12 injured in road accident

Two minors were killed and 12 others injured on Tuesday when a reckless truck driver hit a roadside SUV on the outskirts of the Chhattisgarh capital.  
The deceased were Aradhy Sahu (12) and Monika Sahu (14), Raipur Additional Superintendent of Police (Rural) Kiran Rathore said.  
The injured were Prarthana Sahu, Nisha Sahu, Nirmala Sahu, Dharmendra Sahu, Lalit Sahu, Mahi Sahu, Om Prakash Sahu, Geetanjali Sahu, Diksha Sahu, Ritesh Sahu, Prerna Sahu and the SUV driver, Narottam Sahu. All of them hailed from Dhamtari district.  
The incident took place around 2 am on National Highway 130 near Siltara when the 14 occupants of the



vehicle were returning to Dhamtari from Amarkantak after a pilgrimage.  
The SUV, with parking and headlights on, was stationed on the roadside of the six-lane expressway for repair. The victims were seated inside and outside the vehicle.  
A cement laden truck (CG-08, AB-811) hit the vehicle from behind, killing two children dead on the spot. The injured were later shifted to Raipur.  
The truck driver, Mahendra Kumar, was caught.
