Police said that the three of them were reported missing on Wednesday afternoon. By evening, their mobile phones were switched off near Pedda Cheruvu

MYSTERY shrouds the death of a sub-inspector of police, a woman constable and a primary agriculture cooperative society (PACS) employee

Police recovered the three bodies from Pedda Cheruvu in Adloor Yellareddy village in the Sadashivanagar police station limits in Kamareddy district on Thursday. The reasons for the deaths are not yet ascertained.

According to the police, the victims were identified as Bhi-knoor SI Saathelli Saikumar (31), Bibipet police constable Kammari Shruthi (32) and PACS computer operator Thota Nikhil (28).

Two bodies were recovered around 12:30 am, while the body of the SI was found after day break.

Saikumar was a native of Kistapur village, Kolcharam mandal, Medak and served at Bibipet before being transferred to Bhi-knoor. He is survived by his wife and a child.

Shruthi was a native of Gandhari and was divorced. Nikhil, hailing from Bibipet, worked as a computer operator at PACS. He also served at the local police station during Saikumar's tenure.

Police said that the three of them were reported missing on Wednesday afternoon. By

evening, their mobile phones were switched off near Pedda Cheruvu

Police later identified the shoes and mobiles of two of the victims, and the car of the SI which was found parked near the tank.

On receiving information, police, Fire and Fisheries department personnel rushed to the lake and recovered the bodies from it.

The bodies were sent to the Government General Hospital (GGH) in Kamareddy for a post-mortem examination. Afterwards, they were handed over to the families for performing last rites.

Shruthi's father, Kammari

Pundarikam, filed a complaint with the police. Police registered a case, and the Sadhashivanagar inspector is investigating the case.

Meanwhile, a rescue team staff member and a police officer suggested that one of the victims may have jumped into the lake first, followed by the others, resulting in all the three drowning. The bodies were found within a five-meter radius in the tank.

According to a police official, Shruthi and Nikhil might have gone to the tank first and later Saikumar went there. Shruthi and Nikhil reportedly jumped into the water, and Saikumar, in an attempt to rescue them, also jumped in and all three met with a watery grave, the official added. Saikumar's family members told the police that he did not know swimming.

Yallareddy DSP A Srinivasulu said: "The families of the deceased have not expressed any doubt, which is making the investigation challenging. The postmortem report and mobile call data may provide further clues to help uncover the mystery."

Kamareddy District Superintendent of Police CH Sindhu Sharma and Additional Police Superintendent Narasimha Reddy are monitoring the situation and expressed concern over the incident. The DSPs from Medak and Yallareddy attended the funeral of two police officers.

HONING TALENT CM Cup-2024 to commence today across TG

11 years after woman's death, husband, kin jailed for 10 yrs

ELEVEN years after the death of a 25-year-old woman, LB Nagar Sessions Court has convicted three persons, including her husband, for 10 years of rigorous imprisonment. According to prosecution, the woman, Indiramma, had died in 2013 after consuming toddy in which her husband Chandanelli Venkatesh and his mother Yadamma and his maternal uncle Buttatala Manaiiah mixed insecticide.

Following her death, her brother Pulapally Kistaiah complained to the Shankarpally police on May 31, 2013 expressing suspicion that she was killed by her husband for a dowry of ₹20,000.

In the complaint, Kistaiah said that his brother-in-law informed him that Indiramma did not wake up in the morning after consuming toddy the previous night. The Shankarpally police had sent the body for post-mortem after conducting a panchanama.

The assistant civil surgeon

of the Chevella Area Hospital performed the post-mortem examination and sent the viscera of Indiramma to the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL), Hyderabad, for chemical analysis. Based on the FSL report, the doctor came to the conclusion that the cause of death of the woman was due to "organophosphate, an insecticide poison along with ethyl alcohol". The chemical analysis report elaborated that the victim's stomach, intestine, liver and kidney were found to contain insecticide poison along with ethyl alcohol. The report proved beyond doubt that her husband along with his mother and uncle conspired to kill her.

Venkatesh also consumed the toddy, nothing happened to him while his wife Indiramma had

died the next day, according to the deposition of her brother in the court.

Kistaiah said that Indiramma's marriage was performed on March 8, 2009 to Venkatesh. At the time of marriage, Venkatesh was given ₹50,000 and three tolas of gold as dowry.

Their marital life was happy for the first one year. But later her husband and mother-in-law Yadamma and father-in-law had started harassing Indiramma frequently for more dowry. Kistaiah said in his deposition that two months back before she was killed, Indiramma had called him to say that she was being harassed by his husband and in-laws demanding additional dowry. Venkatesh's maternal uncle Manaiiah even suggested that Indiramma divorce her husband so that he could marry his daughter.

Indiramma's parents had held a panchayat to settle the issue and sought more time for meeting the dowry demand of Venkatesh. But within two months, she was poisoned to death.

Anna University rape case FIR leaked, NCW demands action

AMID outrage over the sexual assault of the student on Anna University campus and protests by students and opposition parties, a new controversy broke out on Thursday after the FIR filed on Tuesday by the Kotturpuram All Women Police Station (AWPS) in the case landed in public domain.

The FIR had graphic details about the ordeal suffered by the student and her name, address and phone number, sources said.

While the AIADMK and BJP hit the streets on Thursday, and the saffron party alleged that

the accused was a DMK office-bearer, Law Minister S Regupathi rejected the allegations as untrue.

The accused, Gnanasekaran (37), a local biryani vendor, was booked under Section 63, 64 and 75 of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita (BNS), 2023.

Though it's unclear if the FIR was downloaded from the Tamil Nadu police's CCTNS portal, a message on the police website later on Thursday said the FIR was blocked by a competent authority.

Speaking to reporters on Thursday evening, Greater Chennai Police Commissioner

A Arun said a possible software glitch may have allowed the FIR to be downloaded.

Meanwhile, chairperson of National Commission of Women (NCW) Vijaya Rahatkar wrote to Director General of Police (DGP) Shankar

Jiwal stating that the leak of the FIR was a violation under Section 72 of the BNS, 2023, and guidelines issued by the Supreme Court in the Nipun Saxena vs Union of India case.

Strict action must be taken against the police officers responsible for this as it has compromised the identity of the victim, the commission said.
