Meanwhile, the Haryana police has registered three cases at different police stations in Karnal district against four agents of the district on the complaints lodged by the family members of three youths who were among those deported from the US on Wednesday. Likewise, Punjab police also booked a travel agent after the family of a deportee lodged a complaint against a travel agent of Amritsar.

Just a day before Delhi Assembly results are to be announced, the political temperature again rose in the Capital on Friday as Lieutenant Governor V.K. Saxena. following on the demand from a BJP leader, directed a probe by the Anti Corruption Bureau against three Aam Aadmi Party leaders, including former CM and national convener Arvind Kejriwal, for alleging that the saffron party had offered Rs 15 crore each to 16 of their MLA candidates.

It was on Thursday that Kejriwal had alleged that BJP was trying to poach his party candidates ahead and that they had all received calls to the effect. "In the last two hours, 16 of our candidates have received calls that if they leave AAP and join their party, they will make them ministers and will give Rs. 15 crores each," he had said in a

post on "X".

Kejriwal had also wondered why BJP was making these calls when various exit polls were predicting its win in the elections. "These fake surveys have been conducted with the sole purpose of pressuring some candidates. But not even one of our men will bend," he had said.

Subsequently, Delhi minister Mukesh Ahlawat, who is also the AAP candidate from Sultanpur Majra, had acknowledged having received a call in which he was offered

Rs 15 crore to leave AAP and

join the other party.

Reacting to the developments, AAP leader and Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh had said, "this shows that BJP has accepted its defeat even before the results".

In view of the allegations, BJP general secretary Vishnu Mittal wrote a letter to the L-G demanding the registration of a First Information Report and a probe by the ACB or any other agency into the allegations levelled by the AAP leaders.

Foreign jails now have 10,152 Indian prisoners

Govt informs Parliament


As per the information available with the Ministry of External Affairs, the number of Indian prisoners, including undertrials, in foreign jails at present is 10,152, the government informed Parliament on Friday.

Minister of State for External Affairs Kirti Vardhan Singh in a written response to a query in the Lok Sabha shared countrywise data on such prisoners.

The data shared under the head 'total number of Indians under trail and convicted in foreign jails at present' included for 86 countries, including Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, the UAE, Qatar, Nepal, Pakistan, the US, Sri Lanka, Spain, Russia, Israel, China, Bangladesh and Argentina.

While 2,633 Indian prisoners are in jails in Saudi Arabia and 2,518 such prisoners are in jails in the UAE, as per the data shared in his response.

Also, 1,317 Indian prisoners are in jails in Nepal, while the corresponding numbers in Pakistan and Sri Lanka stand at



266 and 98 respectively, according to the data.

"As per the information available with the Ministry, the number of Indian prisoners, including undertrials, in foreign prisons at present is 10,152," Singh said.

The government was asked whether it has come to its notice that a large number of Indians, especially people from Kerala, are boarded in jails in Qatar after the FIFA World Cup.

"As per the information available with the Ministry, the number of Indian prisoners, including undertrials, in Qatari jails is 611. However, due to strong privacy laws, Government of Qatar does not share information on prisoners unless the person concerned consents to the disclosure of such information. Therefore, statewise data of Indian prisoners is not available," Singh said.
