Such incidents resulted in delaying the polling process in the affected booths. One person each reportedly died at Palakkad, Alappuzha and Malappuram after casting their vote and a polling agent died after collapsing at a booth in

SC decision on EVMs exposes I.N.D.I.A. bloc parties that tried to defame EC: Meghwal

NEW DELHI, Apr 26 (PTI)

UNION Law Minister Ariun Ram Meghwal on Friday welcomed the Supreme Court's decision on the use of electronic voting machines in polls and said it has exposed Opposition parties, including the Congress, that had left no opportunity to "defame" the Election Commission.

The court has rejected pleas seeking complete cross-verification of votes cast using EVMs with a Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) and said "blindly distrusting" any aspect of the system can breed unwarranted scepticism.

"The Supreme Court in its decision said that the EVM (electronic voting machine) system is all right, its credible and there cannot be any tampering with it. The Supreme Court has given a fabulous decision. We welcome this decision on behalf of the BJP," Meghwal told a press conference at the BJP headquarters here.

The decision has exposed the Congress and other constituents of the opposition I.N.D.I.A. bloc, the senior BJP leader said and added that they had left no opportunity to "defame" the Election Commission by raising questions on the credibility of EVMs.

People tasted 'real democracy' under PM Modi: Jitendra Singh

JAMMU, Apr 26 (PTI)

THE people of the country, especially those in Jammu and Kashmir, tasted "real democracy" under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Minister Jitendra Singh said on Friday.

On a day when voting is underway in 88 constituencies spread across 13 States and Union Territories in the second phase of the Lok Sabha elections, Singh said the BJP will register a "landslide" victory and form a "stable and strong" Government for the third consecutive term.

"After Modi took over in 2014 the people got a feel of real democracy, especially in Jammu and Kashmir where the grassroots level democracy was strengthened with the holding of panchayat and urban local bodies elections and implementation of the 72nd and 73rd constitutional amendments after the Congress deprived the people of these benefits," Singh told reporters here after casting his vote in Jammu Lok Sabha constituency.

"There is enthusiasm among the voters, especially the firsttimers. The country has witnessed revolutionary transformation in the past 10 years under the leadership of Modi.

PM Modi working round the clock to make India a developed country by 2047: Vaishnaw

RAJKOT, Apr 26 (PTI)

UNION Minister for Railways Ashwini Vaishnaw on Friday said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi is working 24X7 to make India a developed nation by 2047 and the people of the country are lucky to have such a hardworking and visionary leadership.

Addressing a gathering in Rajkot city of Gujarat, Vaishnaw accused Congress of wasting five decades, between 1950 and 1990 and during the ten years of UPA rule from 2004 to 2014.

He said the country was brimming with enthusiasm when it gained independence in 1947. "But unfortunately,

after 1947, the Governments that came during the first four decades finished India's core strengths and entrepreneurial spirit. The four decades between 1950 and 1990 were our lost decades," said Vaishnaw at an event organised by the Rajkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry. "Youngentrepreneurs today

won't believe that during those days you had to contact a Congress leader in Delhi if you wanted to change the design of your car steering or increase production in your factory. Such an ugly situation was prevalent under Congress rule back then," he said.

Vaishnaw, who also handles

Electronics and Information Technology portfolios, said though former PM Atal Bihari Vajpayee took steps to improve the situation, everything came to nought under the Congress rule between 2004 and 2014.

Today, India is the fifth largest economy in the world and may become fourth in the near future, he said. "In 2004, our rank was 11th

in the world. Between 2004 and 2014, everyone expected that we would go up some rank. But, when Modiji assumed office in 2014, it was on 11th rank only, with no change in the last decade. So we lost those ten years," he said.

Firing outside Salman's residence: 2 men nabbed from Punjab sent to police custody till April 30

MUMBAI, Apr 26 (PTI)

A MUMBAI court on Friday remanded to police custody till April 30 two men arrested from Punjab in connection with the firing outside Bollywood superstar Salman Khan's residence in Bandra.

Subhash Chander (37) and Anuj Thapan (32) were produced before a magistrate's court. The crime branch on Thursday arrested the duo, who allegedly provided weapons and cartridges to the shooters, from Punjab.

The police informed the court that the accused were key persons in the crime and were arrested based on technical evidence.

They need to be interrogated to find out who supplied them with weapons and asked them to give the same to the two shooters arrested earlier, police said.

The police have alleged that Chander and Thapan had come to Panvel (in Raigad district near Mumbai) on March 15 to hand over two country-made pistols and 38 live rounds to the shooters Sagar Pal and Vicky

SRINAGAR/JAMMU, Apr 26 (PTI)

NC leader Omar Abdullah and PDP president Mehbooba Mufti on Friday asked the Election Commission not to postpone polls in the Anantnag-Rajouri Lok Sabha seat. The former Chief Ministers made the

appeal after the EC sought a report from Chief Secretary Atal Dulloo and the Chief Electoral Officer on representations submitted by some parties and three candidates seeking rescheduling of elections in the constituency due to adverse weather conditions.

"I appeal to the EC that such a step should not be taken. The demand for postponement is not from all parties. The weird thing is that some of the people who have written to the EC are not contesting. If I write to the EC about constituencies in Tamil Nadu etc. Will they take notice," he told a press conference in Srinagar.

Abdullah said "all options are open", including legal recourse, for his partv if the Election Commission decides to postpone the polls.

"All options are open to us. First and foremost, we appeal to the Election Commission not to do it (postpone the elections). The Election Commission should issue a directive to the local administration to keep the road open," he said.

Abdullah, who was accompanied by National Conference candidate for the Anantnag-Rajouri Lok Sabha seat Mian Altaf Ahmad, said the EC should not pay heed to the letter written by some parties and individuals, including the BJP for postponement of the elections under the garb of closure of the Mughal Road, the fair weather road which connects south Kashmir to Poonch-Rajouri region on other side of the Pir Panjal mountain range. Abdullah said he failed to under-

stand why anyone would seek postponement of an election based on presumption that the road will be closed due to inclement weather.
